ADMINISTRATIVE DECISION

The above matter was heard on Thursday, August 24, 2006 before a Hearing Officer of the Department of Health. The Department of Health was represented by Gregory A. Madoian, Esquire. The Respondent, though properly served by certified mail, elected not to appear.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. The Department of Health asserts and the evidence is uncontroverted that the Respondent failed to maintain his continuing education credits as required by law.
2. The Respondent, after being served with notice for this hearing, indicated in a letter to the Department that he did not, and would not, comply with the continuing education requirements.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Respondent is guilty of unprofessional conduct for failure to maintain his continuing education credits as required by law.

2. As such, the Respondent's license to practice as an Assisted Living Residence Administrator in this state is **suspended** indefinitely.
3. Respondent may apply for reinstatement of said license upon proof that he has completed the required continuing education credits. At that time the Department of Health may impose any other reasonable conditions to the grant of said license.
