

CONSENT ORDER

Pursuant to RIGL 5-69 and the Rules and Regulations promulgated there under, the Rhode Island Department of Health (hereinafter the "Department"), and the Board of Licensing for Chemical Dependency Professionals (hereinafter the "Board"), has investigated a complaint charging Becky Chartier, CDP00426 (hereinafter the "Respondent") with a violation of RIGL 5-69-10.

After review and consideration by the Department and the Board with respect to the allegations of unprofessional conduct of the Respondent, the following are and shall constitute

FINDINGS OF FACT


1. Respondent is a Chemical Dependency Professional licensed to practice in the State of Rhode Island under Chemical Dependency Professional License Number, CDP00426.
2. At all times relevant hereto, Respondent was employed by NRI Community Services, Woonsocket, RI.
3. That on or about October 20, 2014, Respondent renewed her Chemical Dependency Professional license and falsely indicated that she was currently certified by the Rhode Island Certification Board for Chemical Dependency Professionals.
4. That the conduct described in paragraph three (3) herein constitutes unprofessional conduct pursuant to RIGL 5-69-10 and the Rules and Regulations promulgated there under.
5. That the Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of the Department and hereby agrees to remain under the jurisdiction of the Department.

6. That the Respondent has read this Consent Order and understands this Consent Order shall become binding once signed by the Respondent and the Department and/or Board.
7. That the Respondent understands the purpose of this Consent Order is solely to resolve the complaint of unprofessional conduct alleged against the Respondent.
8. That the Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:
  - a) The right to have an Administrative Hearing on this matter;
  - b) The right to represent himself/herself or be represented by an Attorney of Respondent's own choosing at said hearing;
  - c) The right to present testimony, evidence and witnesses on Respondent's behalf;
  - d) The right to cross-examine witnesses presented by the Department;
  - e) The right to further procedural steps except for those specifically contained herein;
  - f) The right to take an appeal from the terms of this Consent Order.

ACCORDINGLY AND BASED ON THE FOREGOING

The Rhode Island Department of Health and the Respondent hereby agree to the following disposition of this complaint:

1. That Respondent is hereby issued the sanction of a Suspension. In order to be relieved from Suspension, the Respondent must provide the Board with proof of completion of an Ethics class approved by the Board, and current certification by the Rhode Island Certification Board for Chemical Dependency Professionals.
2. That this Order shall become part of a public record of this proceeding.
