**VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF CONTROLLED SUBSTANCES  
REGISTRATION**

The Board of Nurse Registration and Nursing Education (hereinafter referred to as the "Board") opened an investigation into the prescriptive practices of the Respondent. The findings of fact and conclusions of law are set forth below.

**Findings of Facts and Conclusions of Law**

1. The Respondent is a Nurse Practitioner with Prescriptive privileges licensed to practice medicine in Rhode Island.
2. After investigation, the Respondent agreed to surrender her Controlled Substances Registration ("CSR"), effective March 11, 2013.

**The parties agree as follows:**

- (a) The Respondent is a Nurse Practitioner with Prescriptive Privileges licensed and doing business under and by virtue of the Laws of the State of Rhode Island, license number, NPP37094 and CNPP37094.
- (b) Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of the Board and hereby agrees to remain under the jurisdiction of the Board;

- (c) Respondent understands that the surrender of her CSR will also result in the surrender of her federal Drug Enforcement Administration Certificate of Registration, which is already expired;
- (d) Respondent understands and agrees that before she can resume the use of her CSR, she must have successfully completed her two year probationary period as required by the Board.
