CONSENT AGREEMENT

This matter came before the Rhode Island Department of Health, Board of Examiners in Dentistry on 12 May 2010, whereby the Respondent, David A. Marcantonio, DDS, petitioned the Board for Relief from its Final Decision and Order. Specifically, the Respondent seeks relief from that portion of the Board's Order which requires him to attend and complete advanced studies at an approved school of dentistry.


After careful review and consideration of the petition, the Board has agreed that the Respondent's license as a dentist shall be reinstated with a five (5) year probationary period contingent upon the following terms and conditions as set forth herein;

- Respondent shall successfully complete the Jurisprudence, Ethics & Risk Management Examination (JERM) administered by the Northeast Regional Board prior to reinstatement;
- Respondent shall complete one-hundred (100) hours of ADA CERP approved CE courses annually during the five-year probationary period that shall encompass the following: Ethics, Record Keeping; Endodontics, and Restorative Dentistry. Courses may be obtained equally in the following venues: Online courses, live or taped courses, classroom lecture courses and clinical hands on courses.
- Respondent agrees to abstain from performing endodontic therapy until he has successfully completed a Board approved hands on endodontic course;
- Respondent agrees to unannounced retrieval and review of patient records;
- Respondent agrees to quarterly review of course(s) completion to ensure compliance;
- Respondent agrees to appear personally before the Committee annually while on probation;
- Respondent agrees to pay the assessed fine of \$10,000 within five (5) years of commencement of this Agreement


The Respondent agrees to the following:

1. That said probationary period shall commence upon the execution of this Consent Agreement by all parties;
2. That said payment of assessed fine (\$10,000) shall be due within five (5) years of execution of the Consent Agreement by all parties;
3. That Respondent shall successfully complete an endodontic therapy course approved by the Board within five (5) years of execution of the Consent Agreement by all parties;
4. That Respondent may petition the Board to resume providing endodontic treatments upon successful completion of the Board approved endodontic therapy course;
5. That during the period of probation Respondent shall be practicing as a duly licensed Rhode Island dentist and provide the address(es) of his place(s) of employment to the Board;
6. Respondent shall meet with the Committee annually during his probation to discuss his progress during the probationary period;
7. That should the Respondent comply with the laws and regulations governing the practice of dentistry during the five (5) year period of probation and comply with the requirements of this Consent Agreement, he may thereafter apply to the Board for an unrestricted license to practice dentistry;
8. That should Respondent fail to comply with the laws and regulations governing the practice of dentistry and/or fail to comply with the terms of this Consent Agreement, his license as a dentist shall be subject to disciplinary action;
9. That the terms of this Agreement shall become effective upon signing by both parties and ratification of the full Board.

10. This Consent Agreement shall become part of the public records once it is accepted by all parties and ratified by the RI Board of Examiners in Dentistry,




