CONSENT AGREEMENT

Pursuant to Section 5-31.1 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, 1956, as Amended, a complaint was filed with the Board of Examiners in Dentistry (hereinafter referred to as "Board") charging George Vezina, DDS, (hereinafter referred to as "Respondent") with violation of Section 5-31.1-10 (19) of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, as Amended, an investigation was conducted by Sub-Committee I, so-called of the Board.


After consideration by Investigating Sub-Committee I of the Board, the following constitutes the Finding of Fact with respect to the professional performance of the Respondent and whereby the Respondent agrees to the following pursuant to Rhode Island General Law 5-31.1-17:

Findings of Fact;

1. That treatment provided by the Respondent to "Patient A" on or about August 28, 1992 through August 17, 2005 failed to conform to the minimal standards of acceptable and prevailing dental care;
2. That treatment provided by the Respondent to "Patient B" on or about February 1, 1995 through August 17, 2005 failed to conform to the minimal standards of acceptable and prevailing dental care;


The Respondent agrees to the following:

- a) To accept a reprimand for failure to diagnose and conform to the minimal standards of acceptable and prevailing dental care in treating "Patient A";
- b) To accept a reprimand for failure to diagnose and conform to the minimal standards of acceptable and prevailing dental care in treating "Patient B";
- c) This Consent Agreement shall become part of the public records once it is accepted by all parties and accepted by the Board. It shall be published in a manner as the Board, in the exercise of its discretion, shall determine.
- d) Failure to comply with this Consent Agreement, once signed and accepted, shall subject the Respondent to further disciplinary action.





