**CONSENT ORDER**

Pursuant to Rhode Island General laws Section 5-31.1-17 and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder, the Department of Health Board of Examiners in Dentistry (hereinafter "Department") has investigated a complaint charging Erin Malloy (hereinafter "Respondent"), with a civil violation of Chapter 5-31.1-10 of the Rules and Regulations.

After consideration by the Department, the following constitutes the Findings of Fact with respect to the professional performance of the Respondent.

1. Respondent is a dental hygienist who was licensed to practice in the State of Rhode Island.
2. For the period July 1, 2012, to October 31, 2012, Respondent worked as a dental hygienist without a license.


The parties agree as follows:

1. Respondent is licensed to practice as a dental hygienist in the State of Rhode Island.
2. Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of the Department and hereby agrees to remain under the jurisdiction of the Department.
3. Respondent has read this Consent Order and understands that it is a proposal of the Department and is subject to the final approval by the Department. This Consent Order and the contents thereof are not finding on Respondent until final approval by the Department.

4. Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:
  - a. The right to appear personally or by counsel or both before the Department;
  - b. The right to produce witnesses and present evidence in her behalf at a hearing;
  - c. The right to cross-examine witnesses;
  - d. The right to have subpoenas issued by the Department;
  - e. The right to further procedural steps except for those specifically contained herein;
  - f. Any and all rights of appeal of this Consent Order;
  - g. Any objection to the fact that this Consent Order will be presented to the Department for consideration and review;
  - h. Any objection to the fact that it will be necessary for the Department to become acquainted with all evidence pertaining to this matter in order to adequately review this Consent Order;
  - i. Any objection to the fact that potential bias against the Respondent may occur as a result of the presentation of this Consent Order to the Department.
5. This Consent Order shall become part of the public record of this proceeding once it is accepted by all parties.
6. The Respondent admits to the Findings of Fact as stated herein.
7. Respondent hereby agrees to this Formal Reprimand.
8. Respondent agrees to the Board of Examiners in Dentistry a check for \$65.00 made payable to the R.I. General Treasury as an administrative fee, due May 1, 2013.
9. Respondent shall be on probation for one year.
