

**VOLUNTARY SURRENDER OF LICENSE**

This matter is before the Department of Health, Division of Emergency Medical Services hereinafter ("Department"), pursuant to a notice of the arrest of Albert J. Vendetti, Jr. the Rhode Island State Police that was received by the Department of Health.

This matter has been reviewed administratively and the Department has concluded that the actions of Albert J. Vendetti, Jr., if proven, would constitute a violation of state and federal law relating to controlled substances. This violation is grounds for action pursuant to the Rules and Regulation Relating to Emergency Medical Services (R23-4.1-EMS)

**Findings of Facts**

1. The Respondent Albert J. Vendetti has been a licensed Emergency Medical Technician since 1989. He is employed by the Providence Fire Department.
2. On April 11, 2007 the Respondent was arrested by Rhode Island State Police and charged with Possession of narcotics with intent to deliver narcotics.
3. Respondent hereby agrees to surrender his Emergency Medical Technician License voluntarily for an indefinite period of time.


Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:

- a) The right to appear personally or by counsel or both before the  
Department;

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- b) The right to produce witnesses and evidence in his behalf at a hearing;
  - c) The right to cross-examine witnesses;
  - d) The right to have subpoenas issued by the Department;
  - e) The right to further procedural steps except for those specifically contained herein;
  - f) Any and all rights of appeal of this Consent Order;
  - g) Any objection to the fact that this Consent Order will be presented to the Department for consideration and review;
  - h) Any objection to the fact that it will be necessary for the Department to become acquainted with all evidence pertaining to this matter in order to adequately review this Consent Order;
  - i) Any objection to the fact that potential bias against the respondent may occur as a result of the presentation of this Consent Order to the Department.
1. This Consent Order shall become a part of the public record of this proceeding once it is accepted by all parties.
  2. Acceptance by the respondent and approval by the Department of this Consent Order constitutes an admission of the facts contained herein.
  3. Failure to comply with the Consent Order, once signed and accepted, shall subject the Respondent to further disciplinary action.



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- 4. The Respondent has Surrendered his license as an emergency medical technician voluntarily pending the outcome of the criminal matter and an administrative hearing at the Rhode Island Department of Health.
