SUMMARY SUSPENSION


Jason M. Jaswell (hereinafter "Respondent") is licensed as an Emergency Medical Technician pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws chapter 23-4.1 and holds license numbers EMT12092 and ERS12092.

Respondent admitted to Smithfield Police on September 18, 2012, that he has bought illegal narcotics more than one hundred times over the previous three years, including the purchase of two Oxycontin pills on September 18, 2012, from an alleged dealer who was under surveillance by Smithfield Police. On that date, Respondent was arrested and charged with possession of a schedule I-V controlled substance.

Based upon the foregoing, and pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws §§ 23-4.1-9 and 42-35-14(c) and regulations pertaining to unprofessional conduct, the Director of Health has determined that the continuation of the license of Jason M. Jaswell as an emergency medical technician constitutes an imminent threat to the health, welfare and safety of the public, and imperatively requires emergency action. Accordingly, the emergency medical technician licenses of Jason M. Jaswell are hereby suspended forthwith. Said suspension shall continue indefinitely pending further Order of the Department of Health.

The Respondent is entitled to a hearing in accordance with Rhode Island General
Laws 42-35-14(c).
