


CONSENT AGREEMENT

This matter is before the Department of Health, Division of Emergency Medical Services (hereinafter "Department"), upon allegations that Joel D. Jillson, a licensed Emergency Medical Technician (hereinafter "Respondent") with respect to the conduct of EMS Refresher Training Program #0298, submitted a letter dated December 27, 1999 which identified that the EMTs on an enclosed list did, in fact, meet or surpass the relicensure requirements per the standards set forth in the Rules and Regulations Relating to Emergency Medical Services (R23-4.1-EMS) and National D.O.T. requirements. The Department has determined that, in fact, this information was inaccurate. With respect to this matter, it is agreed by the parties as follows:


1. That Respondent voluntarily accepts the sanction of a written reprimand for his actions in this matter.
