



CONSENT AGREEMENT

This matter is before the Department of Health, Division of Emergency Medical Services (hereinafter "Department"), upon allegations that Richard J. Lapierre, a licensed Emergency Medical Services Instructor-Coordinator (hereinafter "Respondent"), failed to adhere to the Guidelines for Emergency Medical Services Instructor-Coordinators while conducting an EMT-Basic/Cardiac Refresher Training Program from March 30, 1998 to May 24, 1999. With respect to this matter, it is agreed by the parties as follows:


1. That Respondent agrees to a voluntary surrender of his license as an Emergency Medical Services Instructor-Coordinator for an indefinite period of time effective upon the signing of this Agreement.
2. That should Respondent reapply for said license, Respondent must demonstrate to the Department that he will conduct training programs in compliance with statutory and regulatory requirements.

3. That this Consent Agreement shall obviate the necessity for formal administrative action and shall constitute a final disposition of the matters forming the basis for this Consent Agreement.
