

CONSENT ORDER

This matter is before the Department of Health, Division of Professional Regulation, Board of Hearing Aid Dealers and Fitters (hereinafter "Board"), upon information that Richard Cargill (hereinafter "Respondent") did, on or about 27 June 2000, fail to have Patient A sign a Waiver of Medical Evaluation for Hearing prior to dispensing a Hearing Aid to Patient A. This conduct constitutes grounds for the imposition of disciplinary sanctions pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws, Section 5-49-12(b). Prior to initiating administrative action to impose the disciplinary sanctions, it was agreed by and between the parties as follows:

1. That Respondent voluntarily accepts the sanction of a Reprimand.
2. That the terms of this Consent Order shall become effective upon signing by both parties.
3. That this Consent Order shall constitute a final disposition of the matters forming the basis for this Order and obviates the necessity for an Administrative Hearing.
