


practice of hearing aid dealing and fitting.

3. That should Respondent comply with the laws and regulations governing the practice of hearing aid dealers and fitters during the five (5) year period of probation and comply with the requirements of this Consent Order, he may apply to the Board for an unrestricted license to practice as a hearing aid dealer and fitter.
4. That should Respondent fail to comply with the laws and regulations governing the practice of hearing aid dealers and fitters and/or fail to comply with the terms of this Consent Order during the period of probation, his license as a hearing aid dealer and fitter shall be subject to suspension and/or other appropriate disciplinary action.
5. That the terms of this Order shall become effective upon signing by both parties.
6. That this Consent Order constitutes a final disposition of the matters forming the basis for this Order and obviates the necessity for an Administrative Hearing.
