ORDER

Pursuant to Section 5-34-25 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, 2004 Reenactment, a complaint was filed with the Board of Nurse Registration and Nursing Education (hereinafter referred to as "Board") charging Donnelle Cahill, LPN, Respondent, with violation of Chapter 5-34 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, 2004 Reenactment.

After consideration by the Investigating Subcommittee of the Board, the following constitutes the Findings of Fact with respect to the professional performance of the Respondent.

1. Respondent is a practical nurse licensed to practice nursing in the State of Rhode Island.
2. That on or about July 29, 2005, Respondent forcibly administered two (2) 25 mg tablets of Seroquel to a resident ten (10) minutes after the medication technician administered the prescribed dose of 12.5 mg.
3. That the conduct described in paragraphs two (2) above constitutes unprofessional conduct as defined in Sections 5-34-24 (6v) in that Respondent's actions fail to conform to the standards established by the nursing.


Based upon the foregoing, the Board hereby enters the following Order:

1. That Respondent has agreed to voluntarily surrender her practical nurse license effective December 11, 2006 for a period of at least five years.

2. That at the time Respondent seeks reinstatement of her practical nurse license, she shall submit documentation to the Board evidencing that he is capable and competent to engage in the practice of nursing.
3. That this Order shall remain in full force and effect pending further Order of the Board.
