**Consent Order**

Pursuant to R.I. General Laws §5-37-5.2, 1956, as amended, (2004 Reenactment) the Board of Medical Licensure and Discipline (hereinafter referred to as “Board”) has received information relating to the Respondent’s health and accepts the Voluntary Surrender of his medical license according to RIGL § 5-37. The following constitutes the Investigating Committee’s Findings:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Afshin Nasser, M.D. is a 1993 graduate of the University Eugeno Maria De Hostos Medical School, in the Dominican Republic and has practiced medicine in Rhode Island since 1999.
2. The Department of Health has been made aware of health issues that may impact upon his ability to safely practice medicine.

**The parties agree as follows:**

Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of the Board.

- (1) Respondent has read this Consent Order and understands that it is effective immediately. Respondent may not perform any activities

or dealings that traditionally require an active medical license (e.g. clinical patient care, purchase or use of prescriptive medical devices regulated by the FDA, etc)

(2) Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:

- a. The right to appear personally or by counsel or both before the Board;
- b. The right to produce witnesses and evidence in his behalf at a hearing;
- c. The right to cross examine witnesses;
- d. The right to have subpoenas issued by the Board;
- e. The right to further procedural steps except for specifically contained herein;
- f. Any and all rights of appeal of this Consent Order;
- g. Any objection to the fact that this Consent Order will be presented to the Board for consideration and review;
- h. Any objection to the fact that it will be necessary for the Board to become acquainted with all evidence pertaining to this matter in order to review adequately this Consent Order;
- i. Any objection to the fact that potential bias against the Respondent may occur as a result of the presentation of this Consent Order.

- (3) Acceptance of this Consent Order constitutes an admission by the Respondent of the facts set forth in paragraphs 1 through 2, inclusive, of the Findings Of Fact section herein. This Consent Order shall become part of the public record of this proceeding once it is accepted by all parties and by the Board.
- (4) Failure to comply with this Consent Order, when signed and accepted, shall subject the Respondent to disciplinary action.
- (5) The Respondent agrees to the Voluntary Surrender of his License to Practice Medicine. Respondent is able to reapply at which time that his current health issues have resolved.
