**Voluntary Surrender**

Pursuant to R.I. General Laws §5-37-5.2, 1956, as amended, (2004 Reenactment) the Board of Medical Licensure and Discipline (hereinafter referred to as “Board”) has received information regarding John Leventhal, M.D. The following constitutes the Investigating Committee’s Findings:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. John Leventhal, M.D. born March 19, 1930 and is a 1961 graduate of Boston University School of Medicine. He has practiced medicine in Rhode Island since 2004.
2. His general medical health has prompted a decision to relinquish his medical license voluntarily.

**The parties agree as follows:**

The Respondent is a physician with an active allopathic license No. 11578.

Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of the Board.


- (1) Respondent has read this Consent Order and understands that it is a proposal of an Investigating Committee of the Board and is subject to the final approval of the Board. This Consent Order is not binding on Respondent until final ratification by the Board.
- (2) Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:
  - a. The right to appear personally or by counsel or both before the Board;
  - b. The right to produce witnesses and evidence in his behalf at a hearing;
  - c. The right to cross examine witnesses;
  - d. The right to have subpoenas issued by the Board;
  - e. The right to further procedural steps except for specifically contained herein;
  - f. Any and all rights of appeal of this Consent Order;
  - g. Any objection to the fact that this Consent Order will be presented to the Board for consideration and review;
  - h. Any objection to the fact that it will be necessary for the Board to become acquainted with all evidence pertaining to this matter in order to review adequately this Consent Order;
  - i. Any objection to the fact that potential bias against the Respondent may occur as a result of the presentation of this Consent Order.

- (3) Acceptance of this Consent Order constitutes an admission by the Respondent of the facts set forth in this Consent Order.
- (4) This Consent Order shall become part of the public record of this proceeding once it is accepted by all parties and by the Board.
- (5) Failure to comply with this Consent Order, when signed and accepted, shall subject the Respondent to disciplinary action.
- (6) The Respondent agrees to the Voluntary Surrender of his License to Practice Medicine.
- (7) The Respondent agrees to notify each state medical board in which he holds a license to practice medicine of this decision.
