CONSENT ORDER

Pursuant to R.I.G.L. 23-17.9-8 and the Rules and Regulations promulgated there under, the Rhode Island Department of Health (hereinafter the "Department"), and the Advisory Board for Nursing Assistants (hereinafter the "Board"), has investigated a complaint charging AARON M DOERFLINGER, NA44600 (hereinafter the "Respondent") with a violation of RIGL 23-17.9-8.

After review and consideration by the Department and the Board with respect to the allegations of unprofessional conduct of the Respondent, the following are and shall constitute

FINDINGS OF FACT


1. Respondent is a Nursing Assistant licensed to practice in the State of Rhode Island under Nursing Assistant License Number, NA44600.
2. At all times relevant hereto, Respondent was employed by Evergreen House Health Care and Waterview Villa Rehabilitation & Health Care Center, both in East Providence, RI and Berkshire Place, in Providence, RI.
3. That on or about January 17, 2013, Respondent failed to provide nursing assistant care to three different residents. Respondent was physically abusive to one resident, while showering; grabbed another resident's arm and refused to give the resident water; and did not provide toileting services to another resident.
4. That on or about March 26, 2013, Respondent was witnessed by staff holding a pillow up to a resident's face and hearing the resident screaming.
5. That on or about July 1, 2013, Respondent was witnessed by staff verbally abusing different residents.


6. That the conduct described in paragraphs three (3), four (4) and five (5) herein constitutes unprofessional conduct pursuant to Section 23-17.9-8 and the Rules and Regulations promulgated there under.
7. That the Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of the Department and hereby agrees to remain under the jurisdiction of the Department.
8. That the Respondent has read this Consent Order and understands this Consent Order shall become binding once signed by the Respondent and the Department.
9. That the Respondent understands the purpose of this Consent Order is solely to resolve the complaint of unprofessional conduct alleged against the Respondent.
10. That the Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:
 - a. The right to have an Administrative Hearing on this matter;
 - b. The right to represent himself/herself or be represented by an Attorney of Respondent's own choosing at said hearing;
 - c. The right to present testimony, evidence and witnesses on Respondent's behalf;
 - d. The right to cross-examine witnesses presented by the Department;
 - e. The right to further procedural steps except for those specifically contained herein;
 - f. The right to take an appeal from the terms of this Consent Order.

ACCORDINGLY AND BASED ON THE FOREGOING

The Rhode Island Department of Health and the Respondent hereby agree to the following disposition of this complaint:

1. That Respondent is hereby issued the sanction of a Reprimand.
2. That this Order shall become part of a public record of this proceeding.
