CONSENT ORDER

This matter is before the Department of Health, Division of Professional Regulation (hereinafter Department), upon matters contained in complaint (C00-094) filed with the Department alleging that on or about 04/17/2000 Aina Esther Akinde (hereinafter the respondent), while employed as a Nursing Assistant by Medical Care Inc. falsely presented herself at the Tockwotten Home as a different nursing assistant. Prior to initiating administrative actions on this matter the Department proposes the following:

1. That the Nursing Assistant Registration issued to the Respondent shall be placed on suspension commencing upon ~~31 December 2000~~ subject to the following: *date amended order is signed*

2. That the period of suspension will be stayed for a one (1) year period of probation.

3. During the one year probation period, Respondent will be employed as a Nursing Assistant. Should Respondent fail to be employed as a Nursing Assistant during all or part of the probationary period, she may request an extension in writing.

4. Respondent will document four (4) hours of in-service in the area of professional conduct.

5. Respondent will provide copies of quarterly performance evaluations from her Nursing Assistant employer during her period of probation which recommend continued employment in order to apply for reinstatement of her registration/license.

6. Respondent will work under direct supervision only, that is not in home health, and during a shift where a professional nurse is on the premises.

7. Should Respondent fail to comply with the terms of this Agreement and or the laws, rules and regulations for Nursing Assistants, the Department of Health will propose further disciplinary action.

8. That the terms of this Consent Agreement shall obviate the necessity for the initiation of a formal administrative hearing before the Adjudication Officer of the Rhode Island Department of Health with respect to the matters contained in the complaint (#C00-~~200~~) filed against the Respondent and shall constitute a final disposition thereof.
