
This is to inform you that the Director of Health has revoked your Registration as a Nursing Assistant effective 15 August 97.

On 1 August 1997 you were informed that the Department of Health after review and consultation with the Nursing Assistant Advisory Board completed its investigation of the complaint against you regarding professional conduct, specifically, that you were convicted of one count of fraudulent claims for service which led to your exclusion by the Department of Health and Human Services from participation in Medicare or any state health care programs for a five year period commencing 31 July 1997.

You were further notified at that time that the Rhode Island Department of Health had determined that this conduct constitutes grounds to revoke or suspend your Registration as a Nursing Assistant or impose other disciplinary action and pursuant to the provisions of Section 23-17.9-8 of the Rhode Island General Laws, that the Department of Health would revoke your Registration as a Nursing Assistant effective 15 August 1997 unless you requested a formal hearing. You did not request a hearing and the Department has revoked your registration effective 15 August 1997 for a minimum of five years. You may no longer work as a Nursing Assistant in the State of Rhode Island. It is necessary for you to forward your Nursing Assistant Registration to this Division by 15 September 1997 or it will be retrieved. You will also be entered into the federal Registry of Nursing Assistants, registration revoked.
