ORDER

This matter came on for hearing at the Defendant Denise D'Errico's request to reinstate her assistant nursing certification license. The Nursing Assistant Advisory Board revoked her license per written order dated July 6, 2006. It has been seventeen months since Denise D'Errico has been under suspension and or has been employed in any Health Care facility in since her discharge from her previous employer on May 4, 2006.

Since the Defendant Denise D'Errico has not been employed in the capacity of a nursing assistant or any other health care occupation since the date of her discharge from her last health care employer, Hopkins Hill Manor which was May 4, 2006, and since she has served a total of seventeen months of suspension, this Advisory Board approves the request to reinstate Denise D'Errico's nursing assistant privileges and license.
