CONSENT AGREEMENT

This matter is before the Department of Health, Division of Professional Regulation (hereinafter Department), upon matters contained in an application for Registration as a Nursing Assistant filed with the Department wherein Frederick Nowak (hereinafter the Respondent) in a self acknowledgment admits to a felony conviction in Maryland in August 1995 related to a banking violation and his present probationary status, the last of three (3) years, as a result of his plea. Based upon the foregoing, and because the conviction was nor related to Nursing Assistant practice nor was it a violent crime, the Department proposed granting the Respondent registration by endorsement of his licensure in good standing in Maryland and placing the Respondent on probation subject to the following terms and conditions:


1. The Respondent will be subject to a one (1) year period of probation commencing on August 1, 1997.
2. That should Respondent implement and comply with the Maryland judicial system and satisfactorily clear his record, and supply evidence of his status to the

Department, the Department will consider Respondent to have fulfilled the conditions of this probation.

3. Respondent will provide the Department with documentation and request reinstatement of his license/Registration without restriction.

4. Should Respondent fail to comply with the terms of this Agreement, his Registration as a Nursing Assistant will be subject to suspension.


5. That the terms of this Consent Agreement shall obviate the necessity for the initiation of a formal administrative hearing before the Adjudication Officer of the Rhode Island department of Health with respect to the matters contained in the application filed with the Department.
