CONSENT AGREEMENT

This matter is before the Department of Health, Division of Professional Regulation (hereinafter "Department"), upon the matters contained in the application for licensure as a Nursing Assistant filed by ILYA REIKHRUD hereinafter "Respondent"). Specifically, information obtained in conjunction with the application filed by Respondent indicated felony drug related convictions. Respondent was sentenced to 5 years suspended and five years of probation effective 09/13/95. Prior to initiation any action to deny a license, the Department proposes:


1. That the Department shall grant the application for licensure filed by Respondent when the application is complete provided, however, Respondent shall serve a one (1) year period of probation subject to the terms and conditions set forth in this Consent Agreement.
2. That said probationary period shall commence upon Respondent's employment and/or performing services as a


Nursing Assistant within a health care facility where he will be under the direct supervision of a registered nurse during the first or second shifts and will abate for the duration of any period in which Respondent ceases to be employed and/or performs as a Nursing Assistant.

3. That during the period of probation Respondent shall notify the Department forthwith in the event that he is charged with any crime by any law enforcement agency in any jurisdiction. The Department reserves the right to take appropriate licensure action should Respondent be charged with a crime in any jurisdiction.
4. That during the period of probation should Respondent fail to comply with the provisions of Chapter 23-17.9 and/or the "Rules and regulations for the Registration of Nursing Assistants.... ", or any of the terms of this Consent Agreement, or the terms of the probation, the Department shall initiate appropriate action with respect to Respondent's licensure status.
5. That during the period of probation, Respondent shall submit to the Department one report from the employer relating to Respondent's conduct and performance, one report from his Parole Counselor and one report from a substance abuse counselor. That it shall be the responsibility of Respondent to submit said reports. Further, the Respondent will provide the Department

with the probation discharge order.

6. That during the period of probation should respondent change employment, he shall notify the Department forthwith of said change including the name and address of the new employers and the reason for the change in employment.
7. That a copy of this Consent Agreement shall be forwarded by the Department to Respondent's current employer(s) and all future employer(s) during the period of probation.
8. That this Consent Agreement shall obviate the necessity for a hearing on the matters forming the basis for this Consent Agreement.
9. That at the expiration of the one (1) year period of probation, and upon receipt by the Department of the probation discharge order as well as a performance evaluation from the Respondent's employer recommending continued employment and counselor's reports, Respondent may apply to the Department for an unrestricted license as a Nursing Assistant. Alternatively, if the Respondent is granted an unrestricted license in Rhode Island as a registered nurse, the stipulations in this Consent Agreement will be satisfied and his Nursing Assistant license will be unrestricted.
