CONSENT AGREEMENT

This matter is before the Department of Health, Division of Professional Regulation (hereinafter Department), upon matters contained in complaint (1-0398) filed with the Department alleging that Iola Caranda (hereinafter the Respondent) willfully acted in an unprofessional manner on 3/19/98 by misappropriating employer property while employed as a Nursing Assistant by Warwick Health Center. Based on the foregoing, the Department proposed placing the Respondent on probation for a one (1) year period subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The Respondent will be subject to a one (1) year period of probation commencing on 4 May 1998.
2. The Respondent will document remedial training in the areas of ethical responsibilities of the Nursing Assistant to total at least twelve (3) hours.
3. The Respondent will be employed as a Nursing assistant during the probationary period and also forward copies of at least two (2) performance evaluations by his employer, in his responsibilities as a Nursing Assistant, which review her basic nursing care, respect for

residents rights and recommend continued employment.

4. That should Respondent implement and comply with the performance evaluations as a Nursing Assistant during the one (1) year period of probation, the Department will consider Respondent to have fulfilled the conditions of this probation. Respondent will provide the Department with proof of completion of the required remedial training prior to 4 May 1999 and request reinstatement of registration in good standing.

4. Should Respondent fail to comply with the terms of this Agreement, his Registration as a Nursing Assistant will be subject to automatic suspension. If Respondent is not employed as a Nursing Assistant during all or part of the one (1) year probationary period, she may apply for an extension.

5. That the terms of this Consent Agreement shall obviate the necessity for the initiation of a formal administrative hearing before the Adjudication Officer of the Rhode Island Department of Health with respect to the matters contained in the complaint (1-0398) filed against the Respondent.
