




CONSENT ORDER

This matter is before the Department of Health, Division of Professional Regulation (hereinafter Department), upon allegations that James Oisamaiye (hereinafter Respondent) did engage in conduct which could constitute grounds for disciplinary action while employed as a Nursing Assistant by Edmund Place. This conduct is alleged to have occurred on or about 10 March 1997 and 20 April 1998. Prior to initiating administrative action to revoke or suspend the Respondent's nursing assistant registration, it was agreed by and between the parties as follows;

1. That this Consent Order is entered into without either party admitting or denying the allegations forming the basis for this Consent Order.
2. That Respondent shall voluntarily surrender his license as a Nursing Assistant in the State of Rhode Island Department of Health, Division of Professional Regulation.
3. The Respondent agrees that he shall not practice as a Nursing Assistant in the State of Rhode Island and shall not reapply for licensure as a Nursing Assistant for a period of four years from the date of the execution of this Consent Order.
4. That at the expiration of the four (4) years from the date of execution of this Consent Order, Respondent may apply for license as a Nursing Assistant and shall meet the requirements for licensure in effect at the time Respondent submits his application.
5. That this Consent Order constitutes a final disposition of the matters forming the basis for this Order and obviates the necessity for an Administrative Hearing.
