CONSENT AGREEMENT

This matter is before the Department of Health, Division of Professional Regulation (hereinafter Department), upon matters contained in a recommendation from the Department of Attorney general related to an allegation of unprofessional conduct whereby Jason Furia (hereinafter Respondent) has voluntarily surrendered his Nursing Assistant registration/license. Based upon the foregoing, the Department proposes placing the Respondent's registration/license in voluntary surrender subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The Respondent shall voluntarily surrender his registration/license as a Nursing Assistant for a period of at least two (2) years from the date of execution of this consent agreement.
2. The Respondent will not object to or appeal the imposition of the two (2) year exclusion.
3. That at the expiration of the two (2) years from the date of execution of this consent agreement, and after completion of a Nursing Assistant Training Program during the two (2) year period, Respondent may apply for

reinstatement of his registration as a Nursing Assistant.

4. That the terms of this Consent Agreement shall obviate the necessity for the initiation of a formal administrative hearing before the Adjudication Officer of the Rhode Island Department of Health with respect to the matters contained in the complaint filed against the Respondent with the Department of Attorney General.
