CONSENT AGREEMENT

This matter is before the Department of Health, Division of Professional Regulation (hereinafter Department), upon matters contained in complaint (#2-0596) filed with the Department alleging that during April 1996 Jessica Boulat (hereinafter the respondent) provided sub-standard care to a resident of the Bayberry Commons Nursing Home while employed as a Nursing Assistant. Prior to initiating formal administrative action on this matter the Department proposes the following:

1. That Nursing Assistant Registration issued to the Respondent shall be placed on probation for one year commencing upon 11/29/96.
2. That the period of probation will be subject to the Respondent successfully completing six (6) inservice hours in the areas of basic nursing care. The inservice must include a demonstration of competency in personal care skills, basic nursing skills, rehabilitation skills as defined in the Rules and Regulations for the Registration of Nursing Assistants ( R23-17.9-NA)
3. That should Respondent comply with the documentation

4. Should Respondent fail to comply with the terms of this Agreement and or the laws, rules and regulations for Nursing Assistants, the Department of Health will propose to suspend her Registration as a Nursing Assistant.

5. That the terms of this Consent Agreement shall obviate the necessity for the initiation of a formal administrative hearing before the Adjudication Officer of the Rhode Island Department of Health with respect to the matters contained in the complaints (#2-0596) filed against the Respondent and shall constitute a final disposition thereof.
