CONSENT AGREEMENT

This matter is before the Department of Health, Division of Professional Regulation (hereinafter Department), upon allegations that Joseph Scalise (hereinafter Respondent) did engage in conduct which would constitute grounds for disciplinary action against him while employed as a Nursing Assistant by The Veterans Home, Bristol RI. This conduct is alleged to have occurred on or about 12/21/95. Prior to initiating administrative action to revoke or suspend or impose other disciplinary action, it was agreed by and between the parties as follows;

1. That this Consent Agreement is entered into without either party admitting or denying the allegations forming the basis for this Consent Agreement.
2. The Respondent agrees that he will serve a period of probation of six months commencing 30 November 1998
3. That at the expiration of the six (6) month period of probation, Respondent will provide the Department with a copy of a performance evaluation completed by the appropriate supervisor within the prior six month period which recommends continued employment.

4. That this Consent Agreement constitutes a final disposition of the matters forming the basis for this agreement and obviates the necessity for an Administrative Hearing.
