Ms. Magnum:

This is to inform you that the Director of Health has suspended your Registration as a Nursing Assistant for a minimum of three (3) years effective 30 June 1998.

On 5/20/98 the Department of Health notified you that it had received a complaint alleging that you abused and neglected a resident of Evergreen Health Center on 9/27/97 while you were employed as a Nursing Assistant.

You were further notified that the Rhode Island Department of Health had determined that this conduct constitutes grounds to revoke or suspend your Registration as a Nursing Assistant or impose other disciplinary action pursuant to the provisions of Section 23-17.9-8 of the Rhode Island General Laws, and that the Department of Health proposed to suspend your Registration as a Nursing Assistant for a minimum of three years effective 30 June 1998 for the aforementioned reasons if you did not request a hearing by 30 June 1998. You did not request a hearing and the Department of Health has suspended your registration. You may no longer work as a Nursing Assistant in the State of Rhode Island. It is necessary for you to forward your Nursing Assistant Registration to this Division by 21 July 1998 or it will be retrieved. You will also be entered into the federal Registry of Nursing Assistants, registration suspended.
