CONSENT AGREEMENT

This matter is before the Department of Health, Division of Professional Regulation (hereinafter Department), upon matters contained in a complaint (#2-1099) filed with the Department alleging that MARIE Hill (hereinafter the Respondent) abused a resident of Mt. St. Francis Health Center on or about 5/08/99 while employed as a Nursing Assistant. Based upon the foregoing, the Department proposes placing the Respondent on probation subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The Respondent will be subject to a sixty day period of probation commencing on 5/8/99. She was employed as a Nursing Assistant during this probationary period.
2. The Respondent has documented remedial training as part of the required twelve (12) hours of inservice in the areas of basic nursing care and residents' rights, abuse and neglect. This inservice was documented and reported to the Department of Health by a supervising Registered Nurse and was accompanied by a performance evaluation/assessment
3. That since Respondent implemented and complied with

the documentation of remedial training and satisfactory performance evaluations during the sixty day period of probation, the Department will consider Respondent to have fulfilled the conditions of this probation.

4. That the terms of this Consent Agreement shall obviate the necessity for the initiation of a formal administrative hearing before the Adjudication Officer of the Rhode Island department of Health with respect to the matters contained in the complaint (#2-1099) filed against the Respondent.
