CONSENT ORDER

This matter is before the Department of Health, Division of Health Professionals Regulation (hereinafter Department), upon matters contained in a complaint (C01-257) filed with the Department alleging that Mary Jesser (hereinafter the Respondent) did engage in conduct which would constitute grounds for disciplinary action while employed as a Nursing Assistant at Homefront Health Care. Prior to initiating any administrative action to revoke or suspend the Respondent's license, it was agreed to by both parties as follows:

1. The Respondent admits to the misappropriation of forty \$40.00 from a client of Homefront Health Care.
2. The Respondent agrees to the immediate voluntary surrender of her license as a Nursing Assistant in the State of Rhode Island to the Department of Health for a period of five (5) years, commencing on the date this Order is signed by the Department.
3. That the Respondent agrees she will not practice as a Nursing Assistant in the State of Rhode Island or

apply for renewal or reinstatement of her license for at least five (5) years.

4. That this consent Order constitutes a final disposition of the matters forming the basis for this Order and obviates the necessity for an Administrative Hearing with respect to the matters contained in the complaint C01-257.
