
This is to inform you that the Director of Health has revoked your Registration as a Nursing Assistant effective 3/15/02.

On 12/07/01 the Department of Health notified you that it had received a complaint alleging that, while employed as a nursing assistant by Mt. St. Francis Nursing Home, you abused and neglected a resident.

On 01/28/02 you were invited to an informal hearing to present your statements; you were again invited to the 3/12/02 meeting, neither of which you attended. On 2/15/02 you were notified that the Rhode Island Department of Health had determined that you did violate regulations as described above and that such conduct constitutes grounds to revoke or suspend your Registration as a Nursing Assistant or impose other disciplinary action pursuant to the provisions of Section 23-17.9-8 of the Rhode Island General Laws. Also, that the Department of Health proposed to revoke your license as a Nursing Assistant for the aforementioned reasons unless you requested a hearing by 15 March 2002. You did not request a hearing and the Department of Health has revoked your registration effective 03/15/02. You may no longer work as a Nursing Assistant in the State of Rhode Island. Please return your license or it will be retrieved. You will also be entered into the federal Registry of Nursing Assistants, registration revoked.
