CONSENT AGREEMENT

This matter is before the Department of Health, Division of Professional Regulation (hereinafter Department), upon matters contained in complaint (#2-0295) filed with the Department alleging that during December and January 1994 and 1996 respectively Michelle Burns (hereinafter the respondent) misappropriated property of clients/residents of the Golden Crest Nursing Home and the Phenix Home Care NSA while employed as a Nursing Assistant. Prior to initiating formal administrative action on this matter the Department proposes the following:

1. That Nursing Assistant Registration issued to the Respondent shall be suspended for one year commencing upon 11/29/96.
2. That the period of suspension will be stayed subject to the Respondent successfully completing one (1) year period of probation during which time the Respondent will complete six (6) inservice hours in the areas of ethical responsibilities of a Nursing Assistant and patient/resident rights.
3. That should Respondent comply with the documentation

of satisfactory completion of the inservices she may apply for reinstatement of her Registration without restriction.

4. Should Respondent fail to comply with the terms of this Agreement and or the laws, rules and regulations for Nursing Assistants, her Registration as a Nursing Assistant will be automatically suspended.

5. That the terms of this Consent Agreement shall obviate the necessity for the initiation of a formal administrative hearing before the Adjudication Officer of the Rhode Island Department of Health with respect to the matters contained in the complaints (#2-0295) filed against the Respondent and shall constitute a final disposition thereof.
