**ORDER**

Pursuant to R.I.G.L. (2001 Reenactment) Section 23-17.9-8 and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder, the Rhode Island Department of Health (hereinafter "Department"), after review and consultation with the Advisory Board for Nursing Assistants, has investigated a complaint charging Monie Greene (NA38735) (hereinafter "Respondent") with a violation of Section 23-17.9-8 of the General Laws.


After consideration by the Department, the following constitutes the Findings of Fact with respect to the professional performance of the Respondent:

1. Respondent is a Nursing Assistant licensed to practice in the State of Rhode Island.
2. That all pertinent times, Respondent was employed by Pawtuxet Village Care & Rehabilitation Center, Warwick, RI.
3. That is, on or about February 27, 2010, Respondent exhibited roughness and force while providing care to a resident.
4. That is, on or about March 24, 2010, Respondent exhibited roughness while providing care to another resident and exhibited inappropriate remarks regarding a different resident.
5. That the conduct described in paragraphs three (3) and four (4) herein constitutes unprofessional conduct pursuant to Section 23-17.9-8 and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder.

Based on the foregoing, the Rhode Island Department of Health hereby enters the following:

1. That this Order shall become part of the public record of this proceeding.
2. That should Respondent fail to comply with the terms of this Order, Respondent shall be subject to further disciplinary sanctions.
3. That Respondent is issued the sanction of a Reprimand.
