ORDER

This matter is before the Department of Health (hereinafter "Department") and the Advisory Board for Nursing Assistants upon application for registration as a nursing assistant filed by ROBIN ANNE KAY (NA26937-Expired) (hereinafter "Respondent"). Specifically, the Department is in receipt of information indicating that on or about 21 August 2007 Respondent did submit an application for registration wherein she indicated that she had been involved in criminal activity. That on or about 12 October 2007, Respondent filed nolo contendere to a charge of DUI/ Drugs/Alcohol; and Assault of an Officer with Injury; that on or about 15 December 2006, Respondent pled nolo contendere to a charge of Vandalism; that on or about 27 September 2004, Respondent pled nolo contendere to a charge of Simple Assault in 1999.

That the conduct described in paragraph three (3) herein constitutes unprofessional conduct pursuant to Section 23-17.9-8 and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder.

Based on the foregoing, the Rhode Island Department of Health hereby enter the following:

1. That this Order shall become part of the public record of this proceeding.
2. That Respondent shall submit reports from Plaza Psychology and Gateway Healthcare, Inc. Said reports shall be submitted monthly until 30 June 2008.
3. That Respondent is issued a registration as a nursing assistant with the sanction of a Reprimand.
