**ORDER**

Pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws (2001 Reenactment) Section 23-17.9-8 and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder, the Rhode Island Department of Health (hereinafter "Department"), after review and consultation with the Advisory Board for Nursing Assistants, has investigated a complaint charging Ronald Dosma (hereinafter "Respondent") with a violation of Section 23-17.9-8 of the General Laws.

After consideration by the Department, the following constitutes the Finds of Fact with respect to the professional performance of the Respondent:

1. Respondent is a Nursing Assistant licensed to practice in the State of Rhode Island.
2. That at all pertinent times Respondent was employed by Eleanor Slater Hospital, Cranston, Rhode Island.
3. That on or about 18 April 2006 Respondent was negligent in the care provided to a 49 year old ventilator dependent resident who is dependent on staff for all activities of daily living.
4. That the conduct described in paragraph three (3) herein constitutes unprofessional conduct pursuant to Section 23-17.9-8 of the Rhode Island General Laws and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder.

Based on the foregoing, the Rhode Island Department of Health hereby enters the following:

1. That this Order shall become a part of the public record of this proceeding.

2. The Respondent is issued the sanction of a Reprimand.
3. That this Order shall be in full force and effect pending further Order of the Department.
