CONSENT AGREEMENT

This matter is before the Department of Health, Division of Professional Regulation (hereinafter Department), upon matters contained in a complaint (C01-164) filed with the Department alleging that Seante Gyukeri (hereinafter the "Respondent") verbally abused a resident of The Waterview Villa Nursing Home on or about January 1, 2001 and another date in January 2001 while employed as a Nursing Assistant. Prior to initiating administrative action to revoke or suspend the "Respondent's" Nursing assistant registration/license, it is proposed as follows:

1. The Respondent will be subject to a six (6) month period of probation commencing upon the date the Consent Agreement is signed by both parties. The "Respondent" will be employed as a Nursing Assistant during this probationary period.
2. The Respondent will document remedial training as part of the required twelve (12) hours of inservice in the areas of residents' rights and basic nursing care. This inservice will be documented and reported to the Department of Health by a supervising Registered Nurse and will be accompanied by a performance evaluation.

The performance evaluation from each health facility employer must recommend continued employment and satisfactory performance.

3. That the probationary period will commence upon employment of the "Respondent" as a nursing assistant in a licensed health care facility and will abate for any period when the nursing assistant is not employed as a nursing assistant. "Respondent" will notify the Department of Health of any lapse in employment and the probation will be extended until six (6) months of employment as a nursing assistant is completed.
4. That should "Respondent" implement and comply with the documentation of remedial training and satisfactory performance evaluations during the six (6) month period of probation, the Department will consider "Respondent" to have fulfilled the conditions of this probation. Respondent will provide the Department with proof of completion of the required remedial training and request reinstatement of registration in good standing on or before 12/26/01 or request an extension in writing.
5. That should "Respondent" fail to comply with the terms of this Agreement, her Registration/license as a Nursing Assistant will be subject to further disciplinary action.
6. That the terms of this Consent Agreement shall obviate the necessity for the initiation of a formal

administrative hearing before the Hearing Officer of the Rhode Island Department of Health with respect to the matters contained in the complaint (#C01-164) filed against the " Respondent" .
