CONSENT AGREEMENT

This matter is before the Department of Health, Division of Professional Regulation (hereinafter Department), upon matters contained in complaint (1-0399) of filing an application wherein Veronica Bueno (hereinafter the Respondent) acknowledged criminal convictions which may reflect on her professional conduct. The Department placed the Respondent on a one (1) year period subject to the following terms and conditions:

1. The Respondent will be subject to a one (1) year period of probation commencing on 2/26/99.
2. The Respondent will document remedial training in the areas of the patient safety and basic nursing care as part of the 12 hours of in-service required per year.
3. The Respondent will be employed as a Nursing assistant under during the direct supervision of a registered nurse during the probationary period and will forward copies of at least two (2) performance evaluations by her employer, in her responsibilities as a Nursing Assistant, which review basic nursing care, respect for residents rights patient/resident safety and recommend continued employment.
4. That should Respondent implement and comply with the documentation of remedial training and good to excellent performance evaluations and recommendations as a Nursing Assistant during the one (1) year period of probation, the Department will consider Respondent to have fulfilled the conditions of this probation. Respondent will provide the Department with proof of completion of the required remedial training prior to 2/26/2000 and request reinstatement of registration in good standing.
5. Should Respondent fail to comply with the terms of this Agreement, or the Rules and Regulations for Nursing Assistants, her Registration as a Nursing Assistant will be subject to automatic suspension. If Respondent is not employed as a Nursing Assistant during all or part of the one (1) year probationary period, she may apply for an extension in writing.
6. Respondent requested and is granted a one (1) year extension of probation to end 6/30/2001 under the same stipulations.
7. That the terms of this Consent Agreement and the extension of the

probationary period to 6/30/2001 shall obviate the necessity for the initiation of a formal administrative hearing before the Adjudication Officer of the Rhode Island Department of Health with respect to the matters contained in the complaint 1-0399 filed against the Respondent.
