
**ORDER**

This matter is before the Department of Health (hereinafter "Department") and the Board of Pharmacy upon allegations of unprofessional conduct relating to diversion of controlled substances. That on or about July 20, 2009 Respondent was viewed on surveillance tape at the Target Pharmacy #2073, 620 George Washington Boulevard, Lincoln, RI "scooping" oxycodone and placing it in her pocket. An audit of oxycodone 30 mg revealed a shortage of seven tablets.

Based on the foregoing, the Department hereby enters the following:

1. That this Order shall become part of the public record of this proceeding.
2. That the Department is hereby revoking respondent's license as Pharmacy Technician I.
