**SUMMARY SUSPENSION**


Hilda Pena (hereinafter "Respondent") is licensed as a pharmacy technician I pursuant to *R.I. Gen. Laws 5-19.1-16* and holds license number PH102829.

Over the course of several months in 2012, while employed as a pharmacy technician I at Rite Aid Pharmacy #10260 located at 1459 Atwood Avenue, Johnston, RI, Respondent admitted to the diversion of Phentermine ("Adipex P"), a schedule IV controlled substance pursuant to *R.I. Gen Laws 21-28-2.08*.

Based upon the foregoing, the Director of Health has determined that the continuation of the license of Respondent as a pharmacy technician constitutes an imminent threat to the health, welfare and safety of the public. Accordingly, the pharmacy technician license of Respondent is hereby suspended forthwith. Said suspension shall continue indefinitely pending further Order of the Department of Health.

The Respondent may request a hearing in writing by January 11, 2013.
