SUMMARY SUSPENSION


Lisa Clark (hereinafter "Respondent") is licensed as a pharmacy technician I pursuant to R.I. Gen. Laws 5-19.1-16 and holds license number PH101530.

From on or about October of 2012 to March of 2013, while employed as a pharmacy technician I at Wal-Mart Pharmacy #10-2283 located at 650 Centre of New England Blvd, Coventry, RI, Respondent admitted to the diversion of controlled substances. Records indicate an approximate 1,116 tablet loss of various strengths of the schedule III and IV controlled substances Hydrocodone/Acetaminophen ("Vicodin") and Alprazolam ("Xanax"). In addition, on or about March 10, 2013 Respondent was observed on video surveillance to conceal and consume these substances while on duty and practicing in the pharmacy at Wal-Mart #10-2283.

Pursuant to the provisions of RIGL § 42-35-14(c), the Director of Health has determined that the continuation of the license of Respondent as a pharmacy technician constitutes an imminent threat to the health, welfare and safety of the public. Accordingly, the pharmacy technician license of Respondent is hereby suspended forthwith. Said suspension shall continue indefinitely pending further Order of the Department of Health.

The Respondent has a right to a hearing under RIGL § 42-35-14(c). Hearing requests may be submitted to Department of Health, Legal Department, Three Capitol Hill, Providence, RI 02908, in writing on or before July 17, 2013.
