IMMEDIATE COMPLIANCE ORDER

Now comes the Director of Health of the State of Rhode Island, and pursuant to Rhode Island General Laws 23-1-21 makes the following Findings and Order regarding

FINDINGS


1. Apothecare Compounding Solutions is a licensed retail pharmacy pursuant to RI general Laws 5-19.1, carrying out pharmacy activities with a location at 3303 South County Trail, East Greenwich, RI 02818. Said retail pharmacy is subject to the licensing laws of the state of Rhode Island.
2. The Rhode Island Department of Health, Board of Pharmacy has determined by virtue of on-site inspection at Apothecare Compounding Solutions, 3303 South County Trail, East Greenwich, RI 02818 that the pharmacy was in possession of numerous misbranded pharmaceuticals and the premises was found to be disorderly and disheveled.
3. On March 23, 2012, Michael Fine, MD, Director, RI Department of Health, did summarily suspend the license of Leo Blais, RPh, Pharmacist-in-Charge of Apothecare Compounding Solutions.

ORDER

After consideration of the above findings, it is hereby ordered that Mark Gilmore, owner of Apothecare Compounding Solutions, must immediately comply with the following:

1. Respondent is hereby ordered to employ a Pharmacist-in-Charge by close of business March 23, 2012. If respondent fails to submit a name to the Department, said pharmacy shall not be permitted to continue pharmacy operations thereafter.
2. Respondent shall ensure that all misbranded items are removed from stock and shall maintain items embargoed by Inspectors in a secured location until further notice.
3. Respondent shall clean, organize and remove clutter from compounding work areas.


The Department will monitor the Facility's compliance.
