ORDER


This matter is before the Department of Health (hereinafter "Department") and the Board of Pharmacy upon allegations of unprofessional conduct relating to the diversion of controlled substances. That on or about September 12, 2010 Respondent assumed a false identity as a physician, telephoned in a prescription for himself for a schedule II controlled substance, then attempted to pick up the prescription at Rite Aid Pharmacy located at 1510 Smith Street, North Providence, RI.

In addition, Respondent having graduated from an accredited college of pharmacy in May of 2009, and not currently making significant progress towards obtaining licensure as a Registered Pharmacist, fails to qualify for licensure as an intern in accordance to R5-19.1-PHAR-6.10.

Based on the foregoing, the Department hereby enters the following:

1. That this Order shall become part of the public record of this proceeding.
2. That the Department is hereby revoking Respondent's license as a Pharmacist Limited (Intern).
