



2. Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of the Board and hereby agrees to remain under jurisdiction of the Department.
3. Respondent has read this Consent Order and understands that it is a proposal of the Department and is subject to the final approval by the Department. This Consent Order and the contents thereof are not binding on Respondent until final approval by the Department.
4. Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:
  - a) The right to appear personally or by counsel or both before the Department;
  - b) The right to produce witnesses and evidence in her behalf at a hearing;
  - c) The right to cross-examine witnesses;
  - d) The right to have subpoenas issued by the Department;
  - e) The right to further procedural steps except for those specifically contained herein; and
  - f) Any and all rights of appeal of this Consent Order.
5. This Consent Order shall become part of the public record of this proceeding once it is accepted by all parties.
6. Acceptance by the Respondent and approval by the Department of this Consent Order constitutes an admission of the facts contained herein.
7. Respondent agrees to a one (1) year suspension of her license as a psychologist in this state.
8. That upon execution of this Order by both parties the Respondent shall submit to an evaluation by a Board-approved mental health professional and then submit to the

appropriate therapy as recommended by the evaluation. The recommended therapy is to be prescribed by a Board-approved mental health professional.

9. That during the period of suspension Respondent shall complete coursework in ethics and professional boundaries. Said coursework must be submitted for board approval prior to registration for the course.

10. That should Respondent comply with the requirements of this Consent Order, she may apply to the Board for reinstatement following a period of eight (8) months subject to Board approval and discretion and any reasonable conditions thereto.

11. This Consent Order obviates the need of a formal administrative hearing regarding this matter.
