ORDER

Pursuant to Section 5-34-25 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, 2004 Reenactment, a complaint was filed with the Board of Nurse Registration and Nursing Education (hereinafter referred to as "Board") charging Glynis Feole, RN, Respondent, with violation of Chapter 5-34 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, 2004 Reenactment.

After consideration by the Investigating Subcommittee of the Board, the following constitutes the Findings of Fact with respect to the professional performance of the Respondent.


1. Respondent is a registered nurse and licensed to practice nursing in the State of Rhode Island.
2. That on or about May 10, 2004 Respondent entered into a confidential Diversion Contract with the Board ; that on or about July 9, 2006 Respondent indicated that she has suffered a temporary relapse.
3. That pursuant to section 2-34-24.1 of the Rhode Island General Laws, 2004 Reenactment, and the Rules & Regulations promulgated thereunder this constitutes grounds to initiate disciplinary proceedings.

Based upon the foregoing, the Board hereby enters the following Order:

1. That Respondent voluntarily surrendered her registered nurse license effective July 10, 2006.
2. That at the time Respondent seeks reinstatement of the registered nurse license, Respondent shall submit documentation to the Board evidencing that she is capable and competent to engage in the practice of nursing. Such documentation to the Board shall include, but not be limited to, evidence and reports from a Board approved health care professional that the Respondent has consistently been undergoing treatment for alcohol and/or substance abuse, and such other information as the Board may deem appropriate at that time.
3. That this Order shall remain in full force and effect pending further Order of the Board.
