ORDER

Pursuant to Section 5-34-24 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, 2008 Reenactment, a complaint was filed with the Board of Nurse Registration and Nursing Education (hereinafter referred to as "Board") charging Pamela Beth Collett-Willey, RN, Respondent, with violation of Chapter 5-34 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, 2008 Reenactment.

After consideration by the Investigating Subcommittee of the Board, the following constitutes the Findings of Fact with respect to the professional performance of the Respondent.

1. That on November 3, 2008, Respondent's license was suspended in the state of Florida for allegations of being unable to practice nursing with reasonable safety to patients by reason of illness or use of alcohol, drugs, narcotics or chemicals.

2. That on February 5, 2009 Respondent failed to disclose the aforementioned license suspension in Florida on her Rhode Island nursing license renewal application form.

That the conduct described in paragraph one (1 and 2) above constitutes unprofessional conduct as defined in Sections 5-34-24 (1) and (4) in that the Respondent's actions fail to conform to the standards established by the nursing profession.


1. That the registered nurse license issued to the Respondent is hereby revoked for five (5) years effective May 3, 2010.

2. That this Order shall remain in full force and effect pending further Order of the Board.

The Respondent may request a hearing on this matter, which will be scheduled within ten (10) days, if so requested.
