ORDER

Pursuant to Section 5-34-24 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, 2008 Reenactment, a complaint was filed with the Board of Nurse Registration and Nursing Education (hereinafter referred to as "Board") charging Shannon Lynn Fiocchi, RN, Respondent, with violation of Chapter 5-34 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, 2008 Reenactment.

After consideration by the Investigating Subcommittee of the Board, the following constitutes the Findings of Fact with respect to the professional performance of the Respondent.

1. That on December 4, 2009, Respondent plead guilty to felony possession with intent to distribute Oxycodone.

Based upon the foregoing, the Board hereby enters the following Order:

That the conduct described in paragraph one (1) above constitutes unprofessional conduct as defined in Sections 5-34-24 (4) in that the Respondent's actions fail to conform to the standards established by the nursing profession.


1. That the registered nurse license issued to the Respondent is hereby revoked for five (5) years effective January 17, 2010.
2. That the at the time the Respondent seeks reinstatement of her registered nurse license, she shall submit documentation to the Board evidencing that she is capable and

competent to engage in the practice of nursing including negative urine screens for one year.

3. That this Order shall remain in full force and effect pending further Order of the Board.

The Respondent may request a hearing on this matter, which will be scheduled within ten (10) days, if so requested.
