ORDER

Pursuant to Section 5-34-25 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, 2004 Reenactment, a complaint was filed with the Board of Nurse Registration and Nursing Education (hereinafter referred to as "Board") charging Todd Brouillette, RN, Respondent, with violation of Chapter 5-34 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island, 2004 Reenactment.

After consideration by the Investigating Subcommittee of the Board, the following constitutes the Findings of Fact with respect to the professional performance of the Respondent.

1. Respondent is a Registered Nurse licensed to practice nursing in the State of Rhode Island.
2. That at all pertinent times Respondent was employed at The Friendly Home Inc., Woonsocket, Rhode Island.
3. That on multiple dates in March 2008 Respondent did divert narcotics for his own use and admitted to being addicted to narcotics.
4. That on March 19, 2008, Respondent surrendered his registered license to the Board stating that he is currently in treatment for substance abuse relapse.
5. Pursuant to Section 5-34-24 this conduct constitutes unprofessional conduct in the State of Rhode Island and, as such, is grounds to discipline your license.

Based upon the foregoing, the Board hereby enters the following Order:

1. That the registered nurse license issued to the Respondent is hereby voluntarily surrendered effective March 19, 2008.
2. That at the time Respondent seeks reinstatement of his registered nurse license, he shall submit, including but not limited to, documentation to the Board evidencing that he is capable and competent to engage in the practice of nursing by a Board approved health care provider and other information as the Board may deem appropriate.
3. That this Order shall remain in full force and effect pending further Order of the Board.
