SUMMARY SUSPENSION

This matter came to the attention of the Board of Medical Licensure and Discipline ("Board") by way of an Order of the Board of Registration in Medicine of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts filed with the Board which Suspended Summarily the medical license of Alan Perl, M.D.

This action was taken by the Board of Registration in Medicine following a Motion for Summary Suspension filed by Complaint Counsel for the Board. This Motion referenced the following documents:

1. Statement of Allegations.
2. An affidavit by a member of the Massachusetts State Police.
3. Plymouth Superior Court Indictment in the case of Commonwealth v. Alan Perl, Case No. 96139.
4. List of Controlled substances ordered by Alan Perl from Henry Schein, Inc. from November 23, 1993 through November 10, 1994.

Summary of the Case

The Board of Registration in Medicine has reason to believe that Alan Perl, M.D. has sold controlled substances to an individual for no legitimate medical purpose and has thereby violated G.L.c. 94C, Sec. 32A.

Facts of the Case

1. Alan Perl, M.D. was born January 1, 1946. He is a 1977 graduate of the State University of New York, Buffalo School of Medicine. He was licensed to practice medicine in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts in August of 1980 and in the State of Rhode Island in October of 1980. He maintains an office at 362 Belmont St., Brockton, Massachusetts and 1215 Reservoir Ave., Cranston, Rhode Island.
2. On or about October 18, 1994, Dr. Perl sold 100 tablets of oxycodone with acetaminophen for Six-hundred (\$600) Dollars to an undercover state police trooper for no legitimate medical purpose.
3. On or about October 20, 1994, Dr. Perl sold 100 tablets of oxycodone with acetaminophen for Six-hundred (\$600) Dollars to an undercover state police trooper for no legitimate medical purpose.
4. Dr. Perl did not conduct a medical examination of the trooper or ask for a medical history.

In accordance with Rhode Island General Laws 5-37-8, the Director of the Rhode Island Department of Health makes the following Order.


ORDER

1. Information in the possession of the Board of Medical Licensure and Discipline indicates that the continuation in practice of Alan Perl, M.D. would constitute an immediate danger to the public.

2. The license to practice medicine in the state of Rhode Island, number 5760, issued to Alan Perl, M.D., is hereby Suspended effective December 12, 1994 until further order of the Board of Medical Licensure and Discipline.

3. Alan Perl, M.D. is hereby DIRECTED TO SURRENDER forthwith his wallet medical license card and his wall certificate issued by the Board of Medical Licensure and Discipline.

The Respondent has a right to a hearing pursuant to R.I.G.L. 5-37-8.
