Consent Order

The Board of Medical Licensure and Discipline received an inquiry from a facility into the licensure status of the Respondent who was “moonlighting” in the facility as house doctor. The facility learned that the Respondent did not have an unrestricted license to practice medicine in Rhode Island and an Investigating Committee of the Board undertook an investigation into Respondent’s activities. The following constitutes the Investigating Committee’s Findings of Fact:

Findings of Fact

1. Respondent is a physician who was in Brown University affiliated residency training in the Department of Psychiatry and Human Behavior from January 1994 through December 1998. Subsequently, the Respondent entered into a fellowship in addiction medicine at Butler Hospital from January 1, 1999 to June 30, 2000. During these time periods, the Respondent had attempted to

pass all of the USMLE steps for licensure but was unsuccessful in passing all three steps in the required seven years.

2. The hospital permitted the Respondent to continue a “part-time fellowship” in forensic psychiatry working with prisoners at the Adult Corrections Institution on a limited license.
3. Respondent signed a contract with a facility in which he agreed to terms stating he was licensed by the State of Rhode Island and able to work as a psychiatrist for another facility. This facility is not part of the graduate medical education program under which he was granted “part-time fellowship” status by the hospital.
4. Respondent is guilty of Unprofessional Conduct as defined by § 5-37-5.1 of the General Laws of the State of Rhode Island.

The parties agree as follows:

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The Respondent is a physician with a license number CEF 23530 . Respondent admits to the jurisdiction of the Board and hereby agrees to remain under the jurisdiction of the Board.

- (1) Respondent has read this Consent Order and understands that it is a proposal of an Investigating Committee of the Board and is subject to the final approval of the Board. This Consent Order is not binding on Respondent until final ratification by the Board.
- (2) Respondent hereby acknowledges and waives:
 - a. The right to appear personally or by counsel or both before the Board;

- b. The right to produce witnesses and evidence in his behalf at a hearing;
- c. The right to cross examine witnesses;
- d. The right to have subpoenas issued by the Board;
- e. The right to further procedural steps except for specifically contained herein;
- f. Any and all rights of appeal of this Consent Order;
- g. Any objection to the fact that this Consent Order will be presented to the Board for consideration and review;
- h. Any objection to the fact that it will be necessary for the Board to become acquainted with all evidence pertaining to this matter in order to review adequately this Consent Order;
- i. Any objection to the fact that potential bias against the Respondent may occur as a result of the presentation of this Consent Order.

- (3) Acceptance of this Consent Order constitutes an admission by the Respondent of the facts set forth herein.
- (4) This Consent Order shall become part of the public record of this proceeding once it is accepted by all parties and by the Board.
- (5) Failure to comply with this Consent Order, when signed and accepted, shall subject the Respondent to further disciplinary action.

- (6) The Respondent accepts the sanction of a Reprimand. Further, Respondent will not be permitted a Limited License for the purpose of graduate medical education beyond June 30, 2005. Respondent must obtain an unrestricted license in order to be permitted any level of practice in Rhode Island beyond that date.
