ORDER

Pursuant to R.I.G.L. (2001 Reenactment) Section 23-17.4-et al. and the Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder, the Rhode Island Department of Health (hereinafter "Department"), after review and consultation with the Assisted Living Certification Board, has investigated a complaint charging Gregory Andrade (hereinafter "Respondent") with a violation of Section 23-17.4-et al. of the General Laws.

Following the scheduling of an Administrative Hearing, the parties agreed to the following said Findings of Fact with respect to the professional performance of the Respondent:

1. Respondent is a licensed Assisted Living Residence Administrator and able to conduct business under and by virtue of the laws of the State of Rhode Island.
2. That at all pertinent times, Respondent has worked as an Assisted Living Residence Administrator of Beechwood Senior Living Center, 200 Central Street, Central Falls, RI.
3. That on or about November 18, 2004 to the present date, while you were the certified Assisted Living Residence Administrator of Beechwood Senior


Living Center, you did fail to provide for the safe and proper operation of Beechwood Senior Living Center by competent and appropriate employees and did fail to maintain and operate Beechwood Senior Living Center in accordance with the "Rules and Regulations for Licensure of Assisted Living Residences" as evidenced by the Department's survey report.

4. The conduct described in paragraph three (3) herein constitutes unprofessional conduct in Section 23-17.4-et al., and Rules and Regulations promulgated thereunder. Respondent neither admits nor denies said allegations.

Based on the foregoing, the Rhode Island Department of Health hereby enters the following:

1. The Assisted Living Residence Administrator license issued to the Respondent is hereby permanently surrendered.
2. That this Order shall remain in full force and effect pending further Order by the Rhode Island Department of Health.
