



# Rhode Island 2016-2017 Annual Report

Rhode Island Immunization Program, August 2017

## Background

Vaccination is one of the best ways to protect children and adolescents from 16 potentially harmful diseases, many of which can be deadly. The Childhood Immunization Program's mission is to protect all Rhode Island children from these diseases. All school children (birth through 18 years of age) are eligible to receive vaccine(s) at no cost, and all students are required to have documentation of certain vaccines for school entry. Vaccinate Before You Graduate (VBYG), a school-located vaccination program, helps achieve this mission by making 11 important vaccines available to Rhode Island middle and high school students at no out-of-pocket cost.

## Summary of VBYG Participation

- ◆ **A total of 107 schools participated in VBYG program** (see back page for individual schools)
